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Public Comment Policy

A. The Board of Directors shall, at their regular monthly business meetings, accept comment from any interested person on topics that appear on the Board's agenda for that meeting, as well as general public comments.

B. Public comments are subject to the following rules:

1. Each person will be limited to three (3) minutes to offer comments. Statements shall be timed and time limits upheld;
2. Comments should be directed to the Board and not to an individual Director. Neither the Board, nor an individual Director, will respond to questions or statements presented;
3. Statements should not be abusive, and persons making statements should not address their comments to the statements made by other persons in an adversarial manner;
4. The Board chair shall enforce these rules and take action as necessary to maintain order at the Board meeting. The Board chair may abruptly end the comments of anyone being disrespectful to Board members, the administrative team, staff or members of the general public, who fails to restrict their comments to the topic, addresses a topic that would compromise the Board's impartiality or which are of a confidential nature, or otherwise becomes disruptive to or interferes with the orderly process of the meeting. The Board chair may also limit the total amount of time devoted to public comment based on the number of persons wishing to speak and the length of the Board's agenda.

C. The Board will accept written comments and distribute copies to the full Board as appropriate.
